

19. Documents to be produced at the time of interview;

- a) S.S.L.C. Book (Original)
- b) Original mark list of plus two or equivalent qualifying examinations.
- c) 5 Photostat copies of mark list of S.S.L.C. and Plus 2 or equivalent qualifying examination.
- d) Transfer Certificate. (Compulsary)
- e) Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institutions last studied. (6 months validity)
- f) Originals of certificates, 5 Passport Size & 1 Stamp size photographs.
- g) Originals of Cast and Income certificate, If photocopies were attached to the application.
- h) Intimation card/University allotment memo.
- i) Migration certificate in the case of students who have passed from any other University/Board outside state must be produced within a month after enrollement.
- j) An Eligibility Certificate (from M.G. University) should produce in the case of students who have passed from any other University/Board at the time of admission.

Before submission of the Original certificates to the College at the time of admission the student should make sure to keep the sufficient number of attested Photostat copies of both S.S.L.C. & Plus two with them.

RULES FOR ADMISSION

1. Admission to PG and UG Courses are made by the University through Centralized Allotment Process except Management Quota. Applicants to all categories viz General, SC/ST, Management, Sports Quota, Cultural Quota, Physically / Disabled should apply online.
2. Application for admission in the College under Management quota seats should be made in the prescribed form which can be held from the College Office on payment of Rs. 100/- (Rs. 125/-by post) as Registration Fee, which is not refundable. Separate application should be submitted for management quota seats.
3. The registration number and the application number must be quoted in all subsequent correspondence.
4. The application for Degree/PG Course duly filled in should reach the Principal on or before the last date published on the College Notice Board as prescribed by the University
5. Application containing false information will be rejected.
6. Candidates who are prepared to choose either Hindi or Malayalam as additional language alone will be selected for UG admission.
7. Students who are found eligible for admission will be called for the interview for which they should appear, accompanied by their parent or guardian.
8. All columns in the application must be carefully filled in. Attestation of marks should be done in the appropriate pages. Non compliance with the same will entail rejection of the application.

9. Applicants are advised to keep with them sufficient true copies of their certificates to the College Office on Admission.
10. Eligibility of SC/ST/ OEC / OBC/OBC(H) Fishermen students for fee-concession is subject to the orders of the Government, even if selected under centralized allotment process. After obtaining admission the students must produce application form registered via Akshaya Kendra, Income & Caste Certificate (In original), copy of Adhar card, Allotment memo, Bank pass book, SSLC, +2, Degree, as in the case may be. In case of fishermen student an application form duly signed by the fisheries officer concerned and copy of valid fishermen registration certificate should be produce.
11. Remittance and Refund of Fees as per UGC/ Government Norms
12. If any admission is found ineligible by the University later such admission shall be automatically cancelled.
13. Fee defaulters will not be registered for the examinaion.
14. Ragging in any form and harassment of women are strictly prohibited in the campus as per the orders of Government.
15. The students shall keep away from the use of illicit drugs (narcotics), alcohol, tobacco etc. which are strictly prohibited and punishable.
16. Mobile Phone, Camera, I pad etc. are strictly prohibited in the campus.
17. Registration is needed for the entry of two wheelers in the campus and four wheelers of the students are strictly prohibited.
18. If the Government or University revises the semester or examination fee structure, the students should pay the fees at the revised rate.
